- Worsler Bay doesn't want to host teams racing as part of the nationals at Easter 2020. Where should this be held? The weekend teams racing at lake pupuke hosted by MB was a great success, could this be the nationals?
- NZIODA will not be putting a bid in for the 2021 Asians. It was decided this was a financial risk.
- The transition from green fleet to open fleet was discussed. This is a difficult transition and sailors could be lost. This year's nationals have 142 in open, Napier 2017 176 in open, KYC 2016 176 in open. Numbers in fleet are down. Talk about implementing an intermediate fleet like Australia, new committee will develop.
- First business for new committee winter sprints dates.
- Dan Slater talked about the need to lift the level in the middle of the fleet. Do we need a coach for the fleet paid from entry fee?
